

Kelly Park Road Corridor Study

FROM ROUND LAKE ROAD TO ROCK SPRINGS ROAD

November 2021



PURPOSE

The City of Apopka is evaluating improvements to Kelly Park Road, from Round Lake Road to Rock Springs Road. This analysis has evaluated alternative roadway and intersection improvements and their impacts to traffic as well as environmental features, utilities, and individual properties. A virtual public meeting is scheduled for Thursday November 18th at 6:00 PM. The purpose of this meeting is to receive input on the alternatives. Meeting details are provided on the back of this newsletter.

ROADWAY NEEDS

Kelly Park Road will need to be widened in the next 10-15 years, between Golden Gem Road and Jason Dwelley Parkway. The typical section consists of a multi-use path on one side of the road and a sidewalk on the other side, a total of four lanes (two lanes per direction), a median, and space for utilities along the edges. Stormwater will drain into the median to minimize utility conflicts. The areas to the west of Golden Gem Road and to the east of Jason Dwelley Parkway will not need to be widened to 4-lanes.


Alternatives

Two alternatives were developed for the 4-lane section. Alternative 1 generally aims to widen along the north side to minimize property impacts to the south. The Alternative 2 alignment included widening to both sides of the road, requiring property acquisition from both sides. This impacts more properties but requires less acquisition per property.
